## *Highlights of the TRP 2005 Regional Results*

### **283 sites – 113,242 employees**

Up slightly (.58 percent) from 2004 for employees and a 1.43 percent increase of sites  
Program employees comprise 29% of total regional workforce (Pima County, 2004 ACS).

### **Average survey response rate – 86.4 percent**

Well above the 70 percent minimum goal, and slightly down from 86.6 percent in 2004

### **Survey processing methods:**

35 percent electronic-online (fifth full year)  
20 percent scanned in-house – down from 25%  
45 percent data entered by outside code house – down from 52 percent

### **Average Alternate Mode Usage (AMU) – 30.4%**

Short of 38% regional goal, but up 72.7% from when program began in 1989  
Individual employer goals range from 15% to 38%, depending on time in program.  
Employers achieved AMU from 2 percent to 84 percent

### **Average one-way weekly Vehicle Miles Traveled (VMT) – 57.4 miles**

Up slightly from 57.1 miles after a two year decrease

### **Work related trips – consistent with previous years**

Morning peak, 8 a.m.  
Evening peak, 5 p.m.

### **Average one-way trip – 13 miles and 23.1 minutes**

National average for commute time is 22.9 minutes (ACS, 2004)

### **Regional Results baseline (1989) comparison**

Number of sites – 91.2 percent growth  
Number of employees – 47 percent growth  
Survey response rate – 26 percent improvement  
Alternate mode usage – 73 percent improvement  
Vehicle miles traveled – 21.4 percent increase (goal is 1.5% decrease from year to year)

### **Overall sites meeting one goal – 46.3 percent** (up from 40.1 percent in 2004)

13 percent met both AMU and VMT goals

### **Savings in one year – all up from 2004**

89.6 million miles; 4.5 million gallons of gasoline; \$36.3 million; 3.9 million pounds of pollution
