PROJECT SCOPE: The intersection of Mission Road and Los Reales is an important transportation node in Southwest Tucson. In the last ten years, there have been 28 traffic accidents reported in this location. Recently, a vehicle struck seven cyclists near this intersection, seriously injuring a number of them. For many years, residents have asked for safety improvements at this intersection. This study would examine current traffic conditions, recommend safety improvements, and provide preliminary drawings and designs for said improvements. Pima County has also expressed interest in upgrading features at this intersection to improve safety for cyclists, school buses, and other roadway users.
