## Commuter bike is among giveaways during Alternative Energy EXPO

A commuter bicycle, donated by the City of Tucson and valued at more than \$400, is among the items that will be given away during Pima Association of Governments' Alternative Energy EXPO on Sept. 14 and 15 at the Tucson Convention Center. Also, the first 100 attendees on Saturday will receive a free "Live Green/Go Yellow" T-shirt.

Other prizes include a framed and autographed political cartoon, drawn by David Fitzsimmons of the *Arizona Daily Star*, a SUNLINQ portable solar panel from Global Solar, solar path lights, a \$100 gift certificate from Sun Lighting, gift certificates to C&T Oil, energy-efficient light bulbs and more.

The prizes are scheduled to be given away hourly during the expo, which will be held at 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Sept. 14 and 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Sept. 15. (Note: Prizes are subject to change.)

The region's first-time event of this kind will feature presentations from five nationally recognized authors on the subjects of alternative energy and living green. Panels will be held on the topics of alternative fuels and renewable energy. More than 50 exhibitors and vehicles will be in the North Exhibition Hall at the TCC.

The cost is only \$5 per person and is free to military personnel, students with ID and those under 18.
