## **PAG to accept comments on CO Limited Maintenance Plan at public hearing on April 29**

Pima Association of Governments will accept public comments on a proposed Carbon Monoxide Limited Maintenance Plan (CO LMP) Renewal for the Tucson Air Planning Area at 4:30 p.m. on April 29 in PAG's 5<sup>th</sup> floor conference room in the Transamerica Building, 177 N. Church Ave., Tucson.

This CO LMP Renewal will ensure maintenance of the carbon monoxide air quality standards in the region for a second 10-year period through year 2020. A 30-day public comment period began on March 28 and will end at 6:30 p.m. on April 29.

Interested parties may submit relevant comments, orally and in writing, at the public hearing. The maintenance plan renewal demonstrates continued attainment and compliance with the Environmental Protection Agency's National Ambient Air Quality Standards for carbon monoxide through 2020 for the Tucson area.

The PAG Regional Council is expected to take action on the proposed plan at its May meeting. The time and place for this meeting will be announced at the public hearing and will be posted on the PAG Web site in advance of the meeting. After approval and adoption of the proposed Carbon Monoxide Limited Maintenance Plan by the Regional Council, the plan will be submitted to the state for approval and submission to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.
