The purpose of this letter is to notify you that the RAMP project is being suspended. It is anticipated that work on this project will resume in the next fiscal year, which begins on July 1, 2009. This important effort is being suspended due to a lack of funds. Both of the funding agencies, the Pima Association of Governments (PAG) and Pima County, have difficult budget challenges this year due to the dire state of the economy.

Rest assured that your efforts are greatly appreciated and are important contributions to the RAMP's progress. The staffs of PAG, Pima County, and CLA wish to thank all of the RAMP participants for their time and efforts working on this project. The management team is very appreciative of your cooperation and assistance. It is hoped that you will continue to assist us when the project resume next year.

In the meantime, we will maintain the RAMP website and add to it from time-to-time as meaningful information becomes available from ADOT, other jurisdictions, and professional organizations involved in access management.
