

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pima Association of Governments (PAG) is accepting public comments on a proposed supplement to the Carbon Monoxide Limited Maintenance Plan (CO LMP) for the Tucson Air Planning Area (TAPA). This supplement is in response to the review by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) of the CO LMP for the TAPA that is part of the Arizona State Implementation Plan. This supplement adds the relevant Senate bill from the 48th Regular Session of the Arizona Legislature and Arizona Revised Statute text that reauthorizes the Vehicle Emissions Inspection Program from 2009 to 2017 to Appendix D of the CO LMP that was submitted to EPA in July 2008.

The 30-day public comment period begins on Thursday, April 9, 2009. All comments must be received by May 11, 2009, by 5 p.m. A public hearing will be held on Monday, May 11, 2009, at 3:00 p.m. at PAG in the 5th floor conference room, 177 N. Church Ave., Tucson, Arizona, on the proposed supplement to the CO LMP for the TAPA that will revise the Arizona State Implementation Plan. Interested parties will be given an opportunity at the public hearing to submit relevant comments, orally and in writing.
