**REQUESTED ACTION/SUGGESTED MOTION**

The Regional Council will be asked to approve the proposed FY 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) including the air quality conformity determination and the carryover of any funds from the FY 2017-2021 TIP that remain unexpended at the end of FY 2017.

**ASSOCIATED OWP WORK ELEMENT/GOAL**

Work Element 1541, Transportation Finance and Policy.

**SUMMARY**

- The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), prepared by Pima Association of Governments (PAG), is a five-year schedule and budget of proposed transportation improvements within eastern Pima County. The TIP is typically updated annually through a multi-step process in association with PAG's member jurisdictions and other implementing agencies. The TIP addresses improvements to diverse elements of the regional transportation system including national, state and local highways, transit, aviation, ride sharing, bikeways and pedestrian facilities. The TIP also responds to various state and federal regulatory requirements for development of a transportation improvement program.
- The TPC has developed the proposed FY 2018-2022 TIP, using adopted criteria.
- Full copies of the TIP document have been sent to each jurisdiction and posted online as part of the public comment period. The comment period began April 20 and concluded May 24, 2017.

**PRIOR BOARD AND/OR COMMITTEE ACTION**

- TPC recommended approval of the FY 2018-2022 TIP, the Air Quality Conformity determination, and the 2017 rollovers at its April 19 meeting.
- The Management Committee recommended approval of the FY 2018-2022 TIP, the Air Quality Conformity determination, and the 2017 rollovers at its May 10 meeting.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS**

The TIP is fiscally constrained by funding source in each of the first four years of the program.
