As you know, the Metropolitan Domestic Water Improvement District (District) has been participating on the Scope of Work Committee to process a Pima Association of Governments (PAG) 208 Plan Amendment request from the Town of Marana to obtain Designated Management Agency (DMA) status. This amendment will allow the Town of Marana to provide wastewater collection and treatment services as noted within their plan boundaries. The District believes the Town of Marana has responded to the committee's questions and has the right under State law to be granted DMA status to operate and manage wastewater facilities under its control.

The District would support and recommends PAG Regional Council approval.
